UNLOCKING SDGs WITH LPG

Wednesday 11th, Thursday 12th & Friday 13th May 2022 – 10:00hrs – 14:00hrs (Kenya Time)

This three-day programme will be held virtually, with a 4-hour session on each day, starting on Wednesday 11th May and finishing on Friday 13th May. The programme is designed for all stakeholders involved in the LPG industry who need the latest information on the LPG industry in Africa. The theme is ‘Unlocking the UN Sustainable Development Goals with LPG’.

The first day will be an LPG Summit, with renowned international speakers revealing some of the latest issues that are influencing the development of the African LPG business. Topics will include future supply/demand and pricing, the need for diversity and youth in the industry, the impact of digitalization on the business and how it can make it smarter, the opportunities for innovation - and some of the latest technological developments emerging - and finally the move towards decarbonization and where LPG – and renewable LPG - fits into a net zero future.

The second day will start with panel discussions to hear about what’s going on in Africa regarding the increasing use of LPG and highlighting/addressing some of the main challenges impacting further LPG penetration. Subjects will include the need for a clear policy and a robust regulatory framework, a comprehensive infrastructure to store, supply and distribute LPG consumers, busting the myths, and breaking down the entry barriers when transitioning to LPG from polluting/traditional dirty fuels. The specific roles of government and industry in developing a safe and sustainable LPG industry will also be addressed. The panel discussions will be followed by the start of the training workshop and look at LPG the product, and why we need to fully understand the properties and characteristics of LPG to ensure the safety and sustainability of the business in a growing market like Africa.

The third and final day continues with the training workshop and will appeal more to marketing, technical and operational personnel. It will focus on the good business practices that are needed to ensure the LPG value chain

is not compromised in achieving the goal of a safe and sustainable industry. Case studies will be used on day three to illustrate key threats to the business and will include discussions on how mitigating measures can be used to keep the business safe. Some of the latest innovation will be presented to maintain a smart business presence.

The Summit will be led by Wanjiku Manyara, General Manager of the Petroleum Institute of East Africa (PIEA). The training workshops will be led by David Tyler, Director of the WLPGA, and will be based on the material that has been produced by the WLPGA and its membership as part of its Good Industry Practice programme. There will also be support from invited guests. Polling tools will be used to encourage interaction and quantify knowledge levels. A survey will be conducted immediately after the webinar to determine outcomes.

A communique outlining the outcomes from both the Summit and training workshops will be produced for agreement following the webinar.
