#### Part One - Good Industry Practices in LPG Operations and Management

#### Overview:

- This interactive workshop is supported by key stakeholders within, and related to, the LPG industry, and will focus on the benefits that LPG brings to all, and the economy of Bangladesh. Some of the poor business practices in the country that are limiting LPG penetration will be discussed.

## Objectives:

- To secure common agreement with key stakeholders to address some of the poor business practices that are taking place and develop action plans and a timetable to implement a series of improvements.

#### Structure:

 This workshop will be led by David Tyler, WLPGA Director, and will use actual case studies to examine good business practices from WLPGA's global membership and how they can be applied in Bangladesh.

Part Two – Cooking For Life programme overview, discussing diversity in the LPG industry, understanding LPG's role in achieving the SDGs, including a panel discussion on the opportunities and challenges for the Bangladesh LPG market

### Overview:

This session will build on the discussions in Part One of the workshop to explore what are the key
policy challenges to support further growth across the LPG industry in Bangladesh, how these can
best be addressed using examples from other countries, and how to support the development of
diversity within the local industry.

#### Objectives:

- Underscore the benefits of switching to LPG from traditional fuels.
- Inform stakeholders about Cooking For Life and some of the global initiatives that have been successful, and could conceivably be replicated, in Bangladesh (e.g., Indonesia, India, and Brazil).
- Secure common agreement with all key stakeholders to develop action plans and a timetable to implement a series of improvements.
- Develop a plan to encourage diversity within the industry.
